



## Main Social Welfare Changes and Rates of Payments

### Budget 2016 – Department of Social Protection

**Over €250 million increase in Welfare Support Package for 2016**

**Christmas Bonus increases to 75% this December for long-term welfare recipients – up from 25% in 2014**

**Weekly Pension to increase by €3 for Pensioners and Carers aged 66 and over from January 2016**

**623,000 families to get €5 extra per child per month in Child Benefit**

**New Paternity Benefit to be launched in 2016**

**Carer's Support Grant of €1,700 – to benefit 86,000 Carers**

**Fuel Allowance to be increased by €2.50 to €22.50 per week from January 2016**

**Family Income Supplement threshold to increase by €5 per week for each of the first two children**

#### Pensioners

- €3 increase per week for Pensioners and Carers aged 66 and over – 583,000 people to benefit.

#### Christmas Bonus

**€197 million to be paid to long-term welfare recipients in December**

- A 75% Christmas Bonus will be paid this December to recipients of a long-term Social Welfare payment (minimum payment of €20) – 1.23 million people to benefit.

**People in receipt of the following payments will receive the Bonus:**

- State Pensions and Widow/Widower's/Surviving Civil Partner's Pensions
- Invalidity Pension, Blind Pension, Disability Allowance, Carer's Allowance Domiciliary Care Allowance and Guardian's payments.
- Long-term Jobseeker's Allowance including Jobseeker's Transition Payment, Pre-Retirement Allowance, One Parent Family Payment, Deserted Wife's Benefit and Allowance and Farm Assist
- Back to Work Allowance, Community Employment, Rural Social Scheme, Tús, Gateway and Job Initiative.

## Families with Children

### €98 million extra to support Families with Children in 2016

- A new 2 week Paternity Benefit will be launched in respect of births from September 2016.
- Child Benefit will increase by €5 to €140 for each child per month from January.

- Families with twins receive one and a half times the normal monthly rate for each child. Families with multiple births receive Child Benefit at double the normal monthly rate for each child.

- An extra €3 million is being provided towards the School Meals Programme, increasing the funding to €42 million in 2016.

#### Family Income Supplement

- €18 million extra being provided to increase all Family Income Supplement (FIS) income thresholds by €5 for each of the first two children from January 2016.

The level of FIS payment will continue to be based on 60% of the shortfall between net weekly family income and the applicable weekly family threshold.

## Fuel Allowance increase during the current Fuel Season

An extra €2.50 per week on the Fuel Allowance for long-term welfare recipients, increasing the payment to €22.50 per week from January 2016, with 381,000 households to benefit including pensioners, people with disabilities, lone parents and jobseekers.

## Older People and People with Disabilities

- €3 increase per week for Pensioners and Carers aged 66 and over.
- €2 increase for qualified adults aged under 66 years and an increase of €2.70 for qualified adults aged 66 years or over – 93,500 to benefit.
- €30 million for Carer's Support Grant (formerly Respite Care Grant) to increase by €325 to €1,700 per year paid to carers for each person being cared for.
- Carer's Allowance to be paid for 12 weeks (currently 6 weeks) from January, after the death of the person being cared for.
- €3 million additional funding to fund Free Travel scheme, increasing the funding to €80 million in 2016.

## PRSI – January 2016

- A new tapered PRSI Credit is being introduced for employees insured at Class A whose earnings are between €352.01 and €424 in a week. This Credit will reduce the weekly PRSI bill for over 88,000 employees.
- The lower 8.5% Class A rate of employer PRSI will now apply to weekly earnings up to €376 (up from €356) - 26,000 employers to benefit.

## In-Work Supports

- The earnings disregard for Jobseeker's Transitional Payment will increase from €60 to €90 per week from January 2016 for existing and new recipients. All earnings above €90 will be assessed at 50% (currently assessed at 60%).
- Family Income Supplement thresholds to be increased by €5 for each of the first two children per week from January. The threshold for the third and all other children will be €10.
- Increase in top-up payments for Community Employment (CE), Rural Social Scheme (RSS), Gateway, Job Initiative, Tús and JobBridge participants of €2.50 per week from January.
